- Continuing our Trap/Neuter/Return Programme
- Working with Government to introduce legislation requiring compulsory spaying and neutering of pet cats

What is BFAB?

Bermuda Feline Assistance Bureau is a registered charity founded in 1992.

It is a small but dedicated group of volunteers with a vision of controlling and helping Bermuda's stray cats.

BFAB is committed to:

- controlling the stray cat population through our humane Trap-Test-Spay/Neuter-Release (TNR) programme – with the support of Bermuda's veterinarians – and reducing the number of unwanted kittens being born into the wild
- preventing the spread of disease among the stray and pet cat population
- educating the general public about the need for RESPONSIBLE cat ownership

What Does BFAB Do?

- Trap stray cats in order to have them neutered (TNR)
- Provide medical attention to sick and injured stray cats
- Tame rescued wild kittens for adoption
- Work with other animal organizations, such as the SPCA, Bermuda Cat Fanciers and the Bermuda Audubon Society
- Organise and participate in fund-raising activities which support our goals

How Do You Benefit?

- A neutered cat is healthier and happier
- Fewer cat fights and territory marking makes for quieter neighbourhoods
- A healthier environment... fewer cats means reduced stress on other species

- Have your pet cat spayed or neutered
